Welcome to the dashboard for the Claremont Graduate University survey of Student Satisfaction and Campus Climate. CGU's Institutional Research Office conducted the survey in Novembers. All submitted response data is included here (response counts will therefore vary depending on the question).

Fall 2019: Of the 2018 students who received the survey link, 727 (36.0%) responded to the survey, and 594 (29.4%) fully completed the survey.

Fall 2021: Of the 2,061 students who received the survey link, 541 (26.2%) responded to the survey and 422 (20.5%) fully completed the survey.

Fall 2022: Of the 1,997 students that received the survey link, 632 (31.6%) responded to the survey and 473 (23.7%) fully completed the survey.
