These are the items you'll want to take to the SSN office to apply for a social security number. You can also refer to the website of the SSA for more information.

Practical Training or On-Campus Employment:

Application for SS-5 (available at a SSA office or online)
Valid Passport
Original SEVIS I-20 (indicating CPT or OPT authorization for practical training, or most recent
I-20 for on-campus work)
A copy of your I-94 Arrival/Departure Record
Proof of employment eligibility (job offer letter)
EAD card (for OPT only)
Support Letter from SLDL
• This can be requested at international@cgu.edu along with the following information:

- Student name
- Title of the position
- Name of company
- Supervisor's name
- Start date

Note: You are able to begin paid employment while your SSN application is pending by providing the SSN application receipt to your employer. The SSA website has information on that here.
